ORDINANCE NO. 2197

“AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2190”

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Ridgefield that Ordinance No. 2190, Under Section I of that Ordinance, be, and hereby is amended as follows:

Section I.

Section \_\_\_-6 of that Ordinance, entitled “Anti-Bullying Committee”, subpart (a) be and hereby is amended by deleting the existing language of subsection (a) and replacing same with the following:

-6. Anti-Bullying Committee.

(a) The Borough hereby establishes an Anti-Bullying Committee (hereinafter “the Committee”), to be charged with responding to reports of bullying, investigating reports of bullying and, where warranted, determining appropriate responses to incidents of bullying, including remedial action and consequences as deemed appropriate. The Committee shall also be charged with investigating and implementing programs and methods to inform and educate the various segments of the Ridgefield community about bullying, its effects and ways and methods to deal with same. The Committee shall consist of seven members and two alternates to be appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Council. Committee members and alternates shall serve for a three year term to run on a calendar year basis. The initial appointment of the Committee will have staggered terms so that two persons are appointed for a three year term, two persons for a two year term, and three persons for a one year term so that thereafter for each successive year two members of the Committee will be up for reappointment for a three year term. The initial appointment of alternate members of the Committee will be one year. Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as the appointment, to fill the unexpired term of the member who has left office.

Section II.

Section \_\_\_\_\_-6 of that Ordinance, subpart (c), be and hereby is amended by replacing the existing language with the following:

The Mayor and Council shall select a Chairperson and Vice Chairperson who shall preside at Committee Meetings. The Mayor and Council shall also appoint on a calendar year basis a member of the Council to serve as a Council liaison to the Committee. In addition, there

shall be a liaison to the Committee from the Police Department, which person shall be assigned by the Chief of Police and appointed by the Council.

Section III.

Section \_\_\_\_\_ - 7 that Ordinance, entitled "Reporting Incidents of Bullying", is amended by adding to the existing language the following:

Allegations of incidents or occurrences of bullying by police officers in their official capacities shall not be acted upon by the Committee. Instead, credible allegations of incidents or occurrences of bullying by members of the Police Department in their official capacity shall be forwarded to the Chief of Police and Mayor and Council for further action as appropriate under existing law. In accordance with existing law, the Committee shall not investigate nor impose a remedial measure or consequence in connection with allegations concerning police officers in the performance of their duties.

Section IV: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section V: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication according to law.

## **PLAN TO MEET FEDERAL REGULATIONS REGARDING FEDERAL ROAD SIGN STANDARDS**

The Borough of Ridgefield hereby recognizes its obligations, as per regulations of the Federal Highway Administration, that the Borough adopt a plan to manage its road signs as per those regulations. In connection therewith, the Borough conducted a meeting with representatives of the Borough's Police Department, Department of Public Works, Borough Engineer, Council liaisons and Borough Attorney on February 8, 2012. As a result of that meeting, the following plan is recommended for adoption by the Council.

**1. Present Status:** The Borough has, within its Department of Public Works, the capability to manufacture its own road signs. The Borough's Department of Public Works has, for approximately the past four years, utilized materials which it believes meets regulations as to the reflectivity of signs as recently adopted by the Federal Highway Administration. Accordingly, the Borough believes it is well on its way towards meeting the new mandates.

**2. Street Name Signs and Other Guide Signs:** The Borough recognizes that in the future street name signs will need to include a mix of upper and lower case letters as appropriate. The Borough also recognizes there is no deadline for compliance and no need to replace perfectly good existing signs. The Borough does, however, hereby adopt a sign management plan to the effect that as existing street signs are replaced due to wear, or damage, they will be replaced with signs with the appropriate upper and lower case lettering as required.

**3. Letter Heights on Street Name Signs:** The Borough hereby adopts the recommendations of the U.S. Department of Transportation that in the future street name signs will have the following letter heights:

- (a) For roads of 25 miles per hour or less, the letter heights will be 4 inches.

(b) On signs with speed limits between 25 miles per hour and 40 miles per hour, letter heights will be 6 inches.

(c) For multi-lane roads with speed limits greater than 45 miles per hour, the Borough will have street name signs with 8 inch letter heights.

This plan will be implemented as existing signs are replaced due to wear or damage.

#### **4. Retro Reflectivity of Signs:**

(a) **Verification:** As indicated above, the Borough believes that the sign materials it has been using for the past four years meet the standards for retro reflectivity of signs as adopted by the Federal Highway Administration.

The Borough Engineer will verify that the sign materials being used by the Department of Public Works meet the new federal regulations as to reflectivity.

(b) **Inventory:** The Borough believes that almost all of its street name signs have been replaced with new street name signs that meet the new standards on retro reflectivity. This will be verified by the Borough Engineer. The Police Department shall conduct a survey and report to the Borough Engineer as to those street name signs that do not meet the new standards.

(c) **Schedule:** It is hereby determined that the identification of the signs as set forth above shall be completed no later than June 30, 2012.

(d) **Adoption of Plan for Compliance:** Following the inventory as set forth above, Borough officials will meet on or before September 1, 2012, to review the results of the survey, determine which signs need to be replaced and meet standards on retro reflectivity, to discuss the costs of same, to review dates for compliance, and at that time adopt a revision to the within plan to provide for replacement of signs to meet new standards on retro reflectivity as needed.
