“AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CLOTHING ALLOWANCE PAID TO MEMBERS OF THE RIDGEFIELD FIRST AID AND AMBULANCE CORPS PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 39 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF RIDGEFIELD”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Ridgefield as follows:

Section I: Section 39-1 of Article I of Chapter 39 of the Code of the Borough of Ridgefield be and hereby is amended by deleting the existing language of said section and replacing same with the following:

The following point system will be used to identify the amount that each member of the Ridgefield First-Aid and Ambulance Corps will receive as their quarterly shift-based stipend allowance:

Type of Duty	Number of Points
Night Shifts: 6pm-12a.m or 12am-6am	1
Day Shifts: 6am-10am, 10am-2pm, 2p.m.-6pm	1
Holiday Night Shifts: 6pm-12am or 12am-6am	2
Holiday Day Shifts: 6am-10am, 10am-2pm, 2pm-6pm	2
Being part of responding crew to a general call	1/2

Section II. Section 39-2 of Article I of Chapter 39 of the Code of the Borough of Ridgefield be and hereby is amended by deleting the existing language of said section and replacing same with the following:

Qualifying members will receive \$38 per point and \$19 per ½ point, which shall be paid quarterly.

Section III. Section 39-3 of Article I of Chapter 39 of the Code of the Borough of Ridgefield be and hereby is amended by deleting the existing language of said section and replacing same with the following:

In addition, the officers will receive an additional bonus allowance in accord with their rank to be paid quarterly as follows:

Officer	Amount
Captain	\$ 750
1 st Lieutenant, President	\$ 500
2 nd Lieutenants	\$ 325
Vice President, Treasurer	\$ 125
Secretary, Delegates	\$50

Section IV. Section 39-4 of Article I of Chapter 39 of the Code of the Borough of Ridgefield be and hereby is deleted in its entirety.

Section V. Section 39-5 of Article II of Chapter 39 of the Code of the Borough of Ridgefield be and hereby is amended as follows:

Volunteer First-Aid/EMT and Ambulance Corps member emeritus shall be granted to any volunteer First-Aid/EMT member who has completed and retired after 20 years of service as a full member of the Ridgefield First-Aid/EMT and Volunteer Ambulance Corps and who has also attained the age of 55 years. As a measure of the Borough's gratitude for his or her service, a Volunteer First-Aid/EMT and Ambulance Corps member emeritus shall be entitled to receive a yearly allowance of \$750 for each 20 years served. The right of a Volunteer First-Aider/EMT and Ambulance Corps member emeritus to receive the payment set forth in this section shall cease upon the member's death.

Section VI. In all other respects, the terms and provisions of Chapter 39 of the Code of the Borough of Ridgefield are hereby ratified and affirmed.

Section VII: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section VIII. This ordinance shall take effect upon final publication according to law.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Ridgefield wishes to enter into a Bergen County Trust Fund Project Contract (“Contract”) with the County of Bergen for the purpose of using a \$23,748 matching grant award from the 2018 Funding Round of the Bergen County Open Space, Recreation, Floodplain Protection, Farmland & Historic Preservation Trust Fund (“Trust Fund”) for the municipal park project entitled Veterans Memorial Park Borelli Playground Phase III Improvements, located on Block 2001/2002/1401 Lots 1/1/2 on the tax maps of the Borough of Ridgefield; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council hereby authorize Anthony R. Suarez to be a signatory to the aforesaid Contract; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council hereby acknowledge that, in general, the use of this Trust Fund grant towards this approved park project must be completed by or about March 6, 2021; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council acknowledge that the grant will be disbursed to the municipality as a reimbursement upon submittal of certified Trust Fund payment and project completion documents and municipal vouchers, invoices, proofs of payment, and other such documents as may be required by the County in accordance with the Trust Fund’s requirements; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council acknowledge that the grant disbursement to the municipality will be equivalent to fifty (50) percent of eligible costs incurred (not to exceed total grant award) applied towards only the approved park improvements identified in the aforesaid Contract in accordance with the Trust Fund’s requirements. Professional services costs may be reimbursed from grant award’s unexpended balance, should there be a balance.
