§ 92-1 Salaries.

The rate of compensation of each of the following officers and employees shall be in the amounts as hereinafter set forth as follows. Where a salary range is indicated, the standards to be evaluated in fixing a specific salary for a specific individual shall include education, training, professional certifications, experience, management skills as well as work and salary history and recommendations from other employers.

ORDINANCE NO. 2146

“STATE FISCAL YEAR 2011 ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET  
COST OF LIVING ALLOWANCE AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK  
(N.J.S.A. 40A-4-45.14)”

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A:4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget to 2.5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year’s final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Borough of Ridgefield in the County of Bergen finds its advisable and necessary to increase its SFY 2011 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year’s final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body hereby determines that a 3.5% increase in the budget of said year, amounting to \$504,370 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Governing Body of the Borough of Ridgefield, in the County of Bergen, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the SFY 2011 budget year, the final appropriations of the Borough of Ridgefield shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.14, be increased by up to 3.5%, amounting to \$504,370, and that the SFY 2011 municipal budget for the Borough of Ridgefield be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

“AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 375 “VEHICLES  
AND TRAFFIC” SECTION 375-5 “NO PARKING AREAS” TO ADD ADDITIONAL  
AREAS”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Ridgefield, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, being the governing body thereof, that Chapter 375 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Section 375-5 “No Parking Areas” of the Code of the Borough of Ridgefield be and is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

§ 375-5 No parking areas.

- A. Parking is hereby prohibited on streets or parts thereof in the Borough of Ridgefield as follows:

...

(97) On the northerly side of Maple Avenue beginning at a point 253 feet west from the point where said northerly side of Maple Avenue intersects with the westerly side of Broad Avenue at the northwesterly corner of that intersection, and continuing in a westerly direction from that point a distance of 6 feet to the point of 259 feet.

(98) On the northerly side of Maple Avenue beginning at a point 282 feet west from the point where said northerly side of Maple Avenue intersects with the westerly side of Broad Avenue at the northwesterly corner of that intersection, and continuing in a westerly direction from that point a distance of 8 feet to the point of 290 feet.

(99) On the northerly side of Maple Avenue beginning at a point 590 feet west from the point where said northerly side of Maple Avenue intersects with the westerly side of Broad Avenue at the northwesterly corner of that intersection, and continuing in a westerly direction from that point a distance of 12 feet to the point of 602 feet.

ORDINANCE NO. 2149

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Ridgefield, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey, being the governing body thereof, that Article VII, "Supplementary Regulations", Section 390-18, "Signs", be and is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

§ 390-18 Signs

The following regulations shall apply to all stationary signs and outdoor advertising and shall be in addition to other regulations for specific uses elsewhere in this chapter. For the protection of property values and the character and stability of the various residential, business and industrial districts and for the protection and enhancement of the Borough as a prospective place of residence, employment and commercial, industrial and civic activity and investment, the following requirements are set forth regulating signs in the Borough of Ridgefield:

The word "sign" shall be defined as follows:

Any object, device, display or structure or part thereof, situated outdoors or indoors, which is used to advertise, identify, display, direct or attract attention to an object, person, institution, organization, business, product, service, event, or location by any means, including words, letters, figures, designs, symbols, fixtures, colors, illumination or projected images, but excluding seasonal holiday displays, the American flag or other governmental flags, athletic scoreboards on school premises, or official announcements and signs of government.

The following general provisions are applicable to all zones:

...

C. No sign shall be located within the Borough right-of-way unless no other placement location is feasible to the property owner due to the size and shape of the lot or the existence of previously existing structures on the property. In the case where no other placement is feasible, notice must be given to the Building Department of the Borough so that an alternate location for the sign may be set. This shall not apply to traffic signs and/or other signs installed by governmental agencies.

...

The following signs are permitted in residential districts:

...

J. Temporary political signs shall be permitted under this Section, pursuant to the regulations set forth herein:

...

(5) No temporary political signs shall be placed in the Borough right-of-way unless no other placement location is feasible to the property owner due to the size and shape of the lot or existence of previously existing structures on the property. In the case where no other placement is feasible, notice must be given to the Building Department of the Borough so that an alternate location for the sign may be set; and

(7) No temporary political sign on private property shall be located or placed closer than within 5 linear feet of any other sign of the same candidate or campaign on any one tax lot; and

(9) No temporary political signs shall be permitted on Borough property, except as proscribed by number 5 of this section; and

...

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, Any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.
